The summer camp program

The campus and all the services that it provides were excellent: water, electricity 24/7. It was very comfortable. We found soccer field, basket ball field, a cafeteria, a nice chapel. The kids took a shower several times in a day.

Bible study: Last year we've studied Joseph's life but this year our focus was Daniel. For the whole week, Pastor Gedeon and Pastor Midi were teaching them about the above biblical characters. Our objective was to teach them all the characteristics of Daniel's life, his integrity, his love for God as a man of prayer, a man that made the difference, a man who trusts the Lord. We encouraged the kids to follow the good life example of Daniel.


