From our Director in Haiti:



Despite the chaos which my country is currently facing, there are Christian brothers and sisters who give themselves body and soul, determined more than ever, without any personal interest, for the well-being of

vulnerable Haitian children.

At the end of August, seeing that the Community Church had not been able to raise their full match* for the Rescue One program during the previous year, Mr. Ing. Lamour, in spite of his busy schedule, joined Sister Daniella and her daughter Sandra and formed a strong and highly motivated team to mobilize the brothers and sisters and even the church Executive Committee to find the necessary funds to do this new year's matching for the children. I was amazed to see the determination of the social committee members.

They took the following steps: Lamour wrote a letter to raise funds and sent it to the church members. Sandra developed a pledge form to attach to the letter and, in addition, worked on a PowerPoint presentation with photos of children on different occasions, such as at summer camp, at the distribution of food baskets, and at the distribution of school materials. Sister Daniella made a superb presentation about the program (in which she also thanked you, the donors) and one influential church Executive Committee member interviewed RO staff about the program. The children came to the pulpit and the whole church applauded the noble work that these social committee members are doing in the lives of these young children.

Kerline writes that she was amazed to see the determination of these committee members and that it was an emotional moment for her. In her words, the story is "too good not to share."

What joy to see how God is extending his work in Haiti!

Hello, my name is Hilda. I was born into a Christian home and am the sixth of twelve children. I grew up with my mother and father in the home [The

father in the home [The typical slum home consists of one room made with corrugated metal and with a dirt floor] but sometimes we have aunts and cousins who come to live with us. In our neighborhood there was always turmoil. Often times we could not even sleep and we had to run for our lives.



We weathered a lot of storms but God's grace has always prevailed. I don't even know how God brought me to the Rescue One program. Because our family values education but cannot afford it, I believe this is the greatest opportunity that God offered to me and my family.

In the Rescue One program, I have found another caring family. I have met another mom called Gla [the coordinator of the program] who filled us with love. Thanks to this program, I have completed high school in a good educational institution (Maranatha Christian School) and hope, God willing, to very soon become a university student. I hope to study accounting.

I want to thank all the supporters of this program who are always there for us even though we are facing difficult times. I praise God because you didn't give up supporting us not only with education but also with health care, food, summer camp, spiritual nurturing, etc.... May God continue to bless you for that and surround you with his love.

Today, I can attend some meetings and activities with other people that I never dreamed of. One of my goals since I was a kid is to start an orphanage as well as a small business. If I ever achieve my dream, it is also because of you.

I want to thank God and all the supporters of the Rescue One Foundation for all that you have brought into my life. With all the joy I have in my heart, I want to thank you. May God continue to bless you, protect you, guide you, give you good health, and be with you in all that you do. I love you so much and this love in my heart will never die.
